High school isn't for everyone. Learning disabilities, bullying, illness and financial concerns are just a few reasons some people don't finish high school. We can help when the system fails.

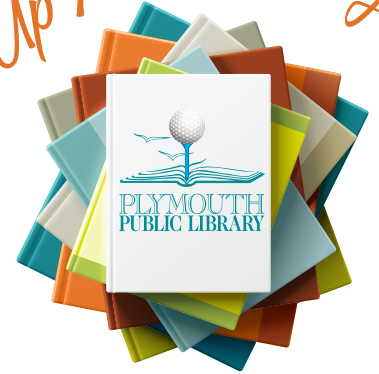
- Nearly 3,000 Plymouth residents over the age of 18 do not have their high school diploma. We meet them where they are and help them move ahead.
- Getting a high school diploma gives a person a sense of pride and builds both confidence and self-esteem.
- A high school diploma opens every previously closed door: college, military service, trade union membership.

- We help people of all ages and backgrounds earn their high school diploma, prepare for college and embark on new careers. Our Literacy Program provides a safe, nurturing environment with free access to teachers who provide students with individual attention and develop learning plans that draw on their strengths to earn their diploma and be on their way.
- Adults who have been laid off - especially after years of experience in their chosen field - often struggle to find similar work. We help with job searches and/or finding retraining programs.
- A well educated work force is better for businesses, employers, and the town of Plymouth. Our work strengthens our community.
- Technology skills are needed in every field and every aspect of our lives. Our Literacy Program teaches students the skills they need in the digital world.
- Adults who learn literacy skills pass those skills on to their children and grandchildren
- Literacy is much more than reading and writing. We offer programs on health and financial literacy too.
- Plymouth County has a large immigrant population – many trying to improve their English language skills: Reading, writing and speaking. Our English As a Second Language Program (ESOL) assists hundreds of students over the course of a year. When our ESOL learners gain English proficiency, they are then able to use the higher education and degrees they often bring with them from their native countries.
